We are so grateful for special gifts that set up the housing and meeting place and provided for personal needs, including medical treatment, for the Bile family. As this work progresses, the team is encountering some resistance in door to door visiting thanks to a weariness and wariness that people have of cults and the dangerous 'revival movement' that is sweeping across West and Central Africa with its false promises of wealth and miracles for those who submit to their strange teachings. If you are active in 'going' with the gospel in your community, you know what this is about and you know the solution—prayer and persistence. Please pray for God to continue to open hearts and give understanding to those who are hearing the gospel.

The arrival of evangelistic literature a few months ago thanks to Colonial Press and the Nehemiah's Network is meeting a huge blessing. Please pray with us as these materials are located around the world and put into the hands of people whose eternal destiny can be changed by the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

My heart is heavy with the burden of raising more regular support for our African co-laborers, Damien Owona and Emanuel Bile. It is clear that we must work to increase their level of support to at least \$300 a month in order for them to meet the most basic expenses of living and doing the work of the Lord. While we are sending at least \$200 a month, their actual support is lower and this is draining finances needed for other aspects of the ministry.
