In the Fall of 2009, it seemed that years of labor in Southern Cameroon had brought forth very little in the way of lasting results. We rejoiced that many precious people who might not otherwise have heard the gospel of Christ came under the preaching of His life changing message, but we mourned the absence of spiritual leadership. The situation seemed hopeless for the villages of that region. But ... God has assembled a team for Project Redemption composed of people from the US, France, and Cameroon and He has given clear direction as to how to proceed!

In January, Yann Jouan and I began preaching and holding daily discipleship bible studies in Akonolinga, Cameroon. We witnessed a dramatic change in the lives of a group of men. During that time, a vision was solidified for the establishment of a new church and a leadership training center. Early in the morning on February 3rd we went down to the river to baptize and later that morning, with no publicity except word of mouth among those we were discipling and meeting with daily, 31 people were present for the inaugural service of Bible Baptist Church of Mount Rouge, Akonolinga. What a sweet time of worship and thanksgiving to God for the work He was doing in all of our lives!

The Lord has directed us to a house large enough for a pastor and his family, some workers, and a training center which can also serve as a meeting place for the church. The house is available for us to buy, interest free, over a period of 10 years – for a very good price. Furthermore, we are welcoming Pastors Damien and Emmanuel as team members with Project Redemption. They have nearly completed their formal studies and are working with us to plant churches in Cameroon and Gabon. Thank you for the prayer and support that allow us to continue!
