Greetings to all of you who support Project Redemption with prayer and finances. A number of people have asked us for information as to what the specific needs are for the work in Cameroon. It's always a pleasure to recount what is God is doing, so here is a straight forward breakdown of it all:

Training Center 'House' in Akonolinga: Purchase price 22,000 Euros (about 30,000 US Dollars). This sum is to be paid in 10 annual payments of 2,200 Euros (3,000 Dollars) due each June, and it is an interest-free arrangement. WE ALREADY HAVE \$400 toward the first payment leaving \$2,600 needed by June.

Monthly Support for national missionaries Immanuel and Damien: 50,000 cfa (about \$100 dollars) each plus help with housing and space for gardens. GOD HAS MET THIS NEED through commitments of monthly support for these men.

Travel Expenses: I have been attempting to raise sufficient monthly support for travel. God has been faithful to cover any shortfalls through His people and by His providence. Our remaining need for projected travel expenses for 2013 amounts to just about \$1600.

Evangelistic meetings for January of 2015: As a solid doctrinal foundation for the church in Akonolinga is being laid, we will be organizing a large open air meeting to attract the local people to hear a message about our Lord Jesus Christ that is distinctly different from that of the 'prosperity preachers' and cultural religionists who predominate the region. Gospel tracts, scripture portions, as well as funds to print publicity materials and to secure a PA system will be required for this to come to fruition. Please pray with us as this develops under the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

Prior to returning to Cameroon in July, I will be covering the pulpit and leading the weekly activities of a church in southern France during the absence of another missionary. It's a privilege to serve churches like this helping to assure their ongoing well-being. In about two weeks, I will attempt to obtain a new visa for Cameroon at the consulate in Paris. This will be my first experience applying for a visa from outside of the US. Please pray that God will direct that process according to His perfect will. Thanks for sustaining Project Redemption and holding us up to the throne of grace.
