The last few months have been filled with preparations for the summer camps here at Camp Rainbow (Arc-en-ciel) as well as the conclusion of the 2011-12 year of the Apollos Program. The Apollos group ended the year by recording a CD with many of the songs we sang as we travelled and ministered in churches over the past 10 months .

The Lord blessed by sending five young American ladies to help with the set up and with running the 2012 summer camps. We are grateful for the help they have been and we praise God for sending them when help was needed the most! The camp season officially started on June 29th with a Bible Week, which is a great way to begin! As I write, we have already seen one woman come to the Lord for salvation this week.
