We greet the churches and want to express our thanks to those who support us financially and spiritually. We love you in the Lord !

We are finding it difficult, if not impossible, to remain in Gabon since the cost of living is much higher than in Cameroon. I have had to bring Blandine back to Cameroon due to an illness but I will be returning to Gabon for the months of July and August. Toward the end of August, I will return to Cameroon and join Pastor Emmanuel Bilé as he is beginning a new church in Sangmelima. This will permit me to care for my family and be with them after a separation of two months. By the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, it will also provide help needed to establish the new church.

In November, we are planning to officially establish new leadership in the church of Minvoul, Gabon with some men who are capable of continuing the work even as I may have to be absent much of the time. The building is ready for the 'chainage' (a perimeter of cement and iron bars) and then will need the roof added. The need to finish it weighs heavily on our hearts since we have either rain or hot sunshine most of the year. However, the finances to finish it are still lacking though the church members have sacrificed to keep the construction moving forward.

We are ready to go where ever the Lord leads to preach, evangelize, teach, and work to bring healing to the souls of African people who live in the absence of the Word of God. Please pray for Project Redemption and for the provision of God for this ministry.
