Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Greetings. My family and I bless the Lord that from the moment of our departure for the ministry, the Lord placed it on your hearts to support the work to which we are called. You could not imagine the impact of your contribution in our lives and ministry. This proves to my family and to me that we are not alone. Psalms 27 is our favorite passage. My family and I bless the Lord for you. To Him alone be the honor and the glory, Amen.

Our ministry is to evangelize the French speaking countries of Africa and of the whole world. Right now the ministry directs us to Gabon to evangelize and plant churches according to the command of the Lord found in Matthew 28:19-20. This task is not at all an easy one. We would ask of you, brothers, by the grace of God, much prayer.

My wife, Blandine, and I have finished our studies in the Bible Institute and are ready to return to the full time care of the ministry in Gabon. We thank you for the provision of funds for Blandine's passport and for our visa applications. When we arrive in Gabon, we will attempt to get temporary residency permits so that we can remain with the work of the Lord over there. God willing, we will bring the children down to be with us for the beginning of the school year.

We are trusting the Lord to provide \$480 for our residency permits and \$160 per month for a house suitable for our family and the needs of the ministry. Housing is more expensive in Gabon than in our home country of Cameroon. The construction in Minvoul, Gabon has advanced as God has continued to provide. The walls are more than half finished. This building will serve a meeting place for the church and a place to train servants of God. Please pray with us that our request to legally establish the church we have planted in Minvoul will be granted.

May the grace of God which surpasses all intelligence rest and dwell in your churches, Amen.
