Dear Churches,

July 2014

May the peace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you. We would like to thank God for all that He does for us and also for the health and He has accorded to us so far. We trust that you are carrying on well, by the grace of God, for this is our desire for you and for your ministries.

Right now, we are in our village for the summer. When we arrived, a number of pastors requested that I come to teach in their youth conference. The youth had chosen the theme 'Evangelism' so I explained to them that evangelism is of no concern to worldlings as the Lord said in Matthew 15:14 «...if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.» This means that a person who is not saved cannot and must not seek to evangelize. On the other hand, evangelism is not the business of a special class of people in the church (Matthew 28:19). Some people think that only pastors should evangelize, but every child of God is called to do it. We see in Acts 8:1,4 that those which were dispersed preached the gospel everywhere as they went but verse 1 tells us that the Apostles were not included in this. At the end of these teachings it came out that almost all of the nearly 80 young people were not yet saved. When I presented the gospel, almost all of them confessed the Lord and received Him into their lives as their personal Savior and Lord. In my analysis, I found that they were not saved because their pastors were not saved either and I understood why the Lord has called us to serve in Sangmelima with a Bible Institute and in planting local churches. In conclusion, please know that, even in our churches today, these unsaved people exist. This is why from time to time we must give messages based on salvation. (Comment from Mark Gostlin – please note that the churches and pastors that Emmanuel speaks of here are from a group that he separated from. They have recently chosen new leaders that respect Emmanuel's separatist and biblical positions and are beginning to submit to sound biblical teaching. Our vision is to establish a teaching ministry aimed at calling sincere, but ignorant, church leaders to biblical faith in Christ.)

On a personal note, concerning the last school year, our children have all passed their courses and our youngest daughter will start school next year, by the grace of God. My wife received her diploma on June 7th after 2 years of study in medical care. We are in the process of enlarging our young cocoa operation and have already planted more than 2 acres. We believe this could help us to support the ministry that God has given us. God willing, we will return to the Bible Institute the end of August for a one year Master's course. We thank the Lord over and over for allowing us to come to the end of these five years of study. Brothers and Sisters, we don't know how to thank you because, without you, the help that we have already been able to give to the people would not have been there. Of course, I'm speaking after the manner of men for I know that it is of God. Pray with us because we need a place to live in town and would like to have one with a room large enough to begin holding bible studies and church meetings. Pray with us as well, that God would provide the tuition for our children's school. May the Lord Himself bless you abundantly and multiply your goods while according you spiritual and physical health; that He would bless Yann Jouan and Mark Gostlin for it is thanks to them that we benefit from your help; and that His name be praised!
