Dear Churches,

May, 2014

May the peace of our Lord Jesus Church be with you all. This morning, meditating on Deuteronomy chapter 8, I focused on verses 14 and 17. In verse 14, the LORD God said the following to the children of Israel before their entrance into the promised land: *"Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;"* Since it is possible to forget the Lord, Israel needed to pay attention to this in their finest moment. Each one of us should reflect deeply on this word concerning our manner of living since the word of God is our mirror.

In reading this passage, I saw a practical application for those in Europe and America.... How many are they who, because of the well-being that the Lord has accorded them, are not following Him and are concerned only about having a nice life? But, by the grace of God, you have come out of the midst of them, having become the children of God. You have put into practice verse 17. Your support of us here in Africa demonstrates that you do not look at what God has given you as being the product of your own strength or of the power of your hands. May the Lord help you to advance in these good works for His glory. And we pray for those who have not yet understood, that the Lord would draw their hearts toward Him.

Everyone in our family is doing well enough except that my wife, Carole, has a sprained ankle. She has finished a course in medical care outside of her theological studies and will receive her diploma on June 7th, Lord willing. The children will have their final exams in the beginning of June. The graduation for the Bible Institute is set for the 6th of June. As soon as the children finish their final exams, we plan to go back to the village for the summer.

Every Sunday we have the worship service in NSAM, and we continue to pray for every aspect of this young church. Pray with us about the vision that the Lord has given to us to establish a training center and to plant churches in Sangmelima, Cameroon – that the Lord would provide the necessary means according to His will.

We also ask prayer that the Lord would provide us a place to live in Sangmelima, starting in December. We will need a house spacious enough that we can begin to gather those that we win to Christ for Bible Studies and, at first, even to hold services and children's Sunday School. I have suffered since 2010 with a malady of the finernails on my right hand. We couldn't find a solution for it here at the clinic of the Bible Institute. It seems that I will need to see a specialist for this. Any help with this need would be greatly appreciated.

Dear brothers and sisters, the words fail us to testify of our thankfulness for all the trouble you have gone to for our education. May the Lord Himself bless you!
