May the peace of our Lord be with you all. First, we want to thank the living God who kept us during the summer and who also permitted us to return to the Bible Institute in very good condition. To Him alone be the glory.

By the grace of God, our family is doing well. The children began school in September and, before going further, we want to give all of our sincere thanks because, without your financial help, none of the children would be in this school. Now, because of this help, all of the tuition has been paid, and all of their notebooks, backpacks, a pair of shoes for each one, and all their most necessary books have been purchased even down to the little one who is in preschool. May God alone bless you.

As for as my wife and I, the words escape us to be able to express the joy that we are experiencing to be completing the final year of our education. This year we have seen your 100% support in everything from our education to our physical health. We pray that your support for the work of God might influence those who benefit from it, whoever they may be, near and far, to take it upon themselves to carry on this same work so that the work of God is continued.

In terms of our activities as students, my wife holds the position of president of female students for the third year in a row and it is also the third year that I, likewise, hold the position of president of male students. Two weeks ago, the school administration made a vehicle available to all the students to attend a seminar in a baptist church in Yaoundé on the theme: "The church and Islam, what must be understood and done." This seminar was of utmost importance because many tend to think that these are unreachable people.

Concerning the ministry: I have made the acquaintance of a young man named Valery Obame who came to the Bible Institute to register but, unfortunately, didn't have the money for tuition to begin. More importantly, after examining him, the directors referred him to me so that I could clearly explain the doctrine of salvation to him and, if it is the will of God, that I might work with him in Sangmelima because he is from the same region as I am and he also left his church to seek the truth. He explained to us that he has gathered a prayer group in that city and since Missionary Mark Gostlin was here, we went together to meet the group and see whether I could come regularly to present salvation and to teach them. I went back to meet with them again and we were nearly 25 in number. I taught on the subject of salvation for two days and during this time, 3 people trusted the Lord. It is my plan now to continue teaching in this city at least twice a month. As far as the young church in Nsam is concerned, we are seeing new visitors often and I am presenting a series of messages on salvation.

Please pray with us for the salvation of our children, of those who come to the church in Nsam, and those are attending the teaching in Sangmelima. Also pray that the Lord would hold me up and direct me in this work and that He would bless it. Pray for missionaries Mark Gostlin and Yann Jouan, without forgetting all those, far and near, who support the work of the Lord
